### EXTRA REMINDER

As always, your **high-res PDF** is your ultimate guide to what will print in your yearbook. Please be sure to print and closely examine your PDF to make sure you like what you see.

### INSTRUCTIONS

Open a **horizontal canvas** in Canva from eDesign. If you're working on the page, you can do this from the blue 'C' in the control panel. If you're in the Art Library, go to Import > Create in Canva.

Click on **Elements** and find the option for **Frame** at the top of the panel. Any shape with the drawing of the rolling hills and blue sky is a frame you can use.

Find the frame you'd like to use and click on it so that it appears on your canvas. *The samples shown above use a torn paper image as a frame.*

Click on the **Uploads** section to find your image. Click and drag the photo you want to use right into the frame. *If there isn't one there, you can click Upload Image to bring one in.*

If you're happy with your design, click **Publish** to send this frame and image back to your eDesign Art Library. *If you want part of the image to break the boundary of the frame, keep following the next instructions.*

Click the image **AGAIN** so that a second copy of it populates on your screen. While the second copy is selected, click **Edit Image** and choose the **BG Remover**.

Position and crop the cut out on top of the framed image so that it's "breaking out" of the frame as you'd like.

Click **Apply** to lock the change to your image, then **Publish** to send the entire design back to your Art Library in eDesign. If you don't see an Apply button, look for the checkmark appearing in the cloud icon to determine if your edits are all properly saved!
