INSTRUCTIONS

Canva gives you access to what seems like a limitless number of fonts. Here's how you can use them in eDesign. We highly suggest you stick with headlines or type-as-art uses only.

Open a horizontal canvas in Canva. If you're working on the page, you can do this from the blue 'C' in the control panel. If you're in the Art Library, go to Import > Create in Canva.

Click **Text** in the left menu of Canva. Scroll through the various effects until you see one that you like. Make your selection by clicking once.

On the canvas, **double click within the text**. This will give you controls on top to choose your font, size and colors. Type in the text you want to appear in the book.

Be sure to leave a bit of perimeter around your text in Canva – you don't want it pressing right up against the edges.

When done, click **Publish** in the upper right corner. Your text treatment will come into your eDesign Art Library as an image you can place in your book.

Important: You cannot edit this text in eDesign because it's an image. You can right click on the image to "Edit Image" to launch it back into Canva to edit it there.

To create additional versions of this same treatment: Right-click to select **Edit Image**. This will launch this same treatment into Canva as a starting point for you.

Type your new headling and click **Publish**. This will create a second piece of art rather than overwriting your original. Rinse and repeat for as many headline treatments as you need.
